### Section I: Voted Debt Service Millage

Include only voted debt service millages levied under s. 12, Article VII of the State Constitution. Do not include levies approved by referendums not required by general law or the State Constitution.

### Section II: Millage Voted Under s. 9(b), Article VII of the State Constitution

Include only millages voted for two years or less under s. 9(b), Article VII of the State Constitution. Do not include levies approved by referendums not

### Property Appraiser Instructions

For any taxing authority levying a voted millage requiring addendum, the property appraiser should check the Yes box on Line 9, Form DR-420, *Certification of Taxable Value*, and complete this addendum. For each of these levies, the property appraiser should complete the levy description and taxable value columns. A separate Form DR-420 should not be completed for these levies.

Sign, date, and forward the addendum to the taxing authority with Form DR-420.

### Taxing Authority Instructions

Each taxing authority levying a voted millage requiring this addendum must complete the proposed millage column for each of these levies.

If any

- Voted debt service millages, or
  - Millages voted for two years or less (section 9(b), Article VII, State Constitution)
- are missing from this form, contact the property appraiser as soon as possible for a revised form. Do not complete a separate DR-420 for these millages.

Sign, date, and return the addendum to your property appraiser with Form DR-420.
