In order to ensure that the extension decal is received by the purchaser in a timely manner, the selling dealer should submit the Application for Extension to the Florida Department of Revenue within 15 days of the date of application by the purchaser.

Instructions for Application for Extension of 90-Day Decal to 180 Days

For convenience, purchasers are encouraged to submit the Application for Extension at the same time the 90-day decal is purchased from the selling dealer. Pursuant to Florida law, however, the purchaser must submit the application to the selling dealer within at least 60 days of the purchase date, or the extension will be denied.

The purchaser must complete the purchaser information portion of the application.

The selling dealer is responsible for completing the selling dealer information portion of the application.

In order to ensure that the extension decal is received by the purchaser in a timely manner, the selling dealer should submit the Application for Extension to the Florida Department of Revenue within 15 days of the date of application by the purchaser.

A check in the amount of \$425.00 made payable to the Florida Department of Revenue must accompany the application, or the extension will be denied.

The purchaser and selling dealer must both sign the application, or the extension will be denied.

The extension decal must be affixed to the center of the original 90-day decal by the selling dealer. The extension decal must be affixed before the 90-day decal expires. If the extension decal is not affixed to the original 90-day decal, the purchaser will be subject to Florida's sales and use tax and a penalty equal to 100% of the tax due.
