**SUBJECT:** Review of Revised Draft TRIM and Maximum Millage Forms for 2008

In late March, the Department of Revenue placed a number of TRIM and maximum millage draft forms for 2008 on our website and requested comments from property appraisers, local governments and other interested parties. We received a number of excellent comments and suggestions. These revised forms also include changes in calculations as are result of CS/SB 1588, which has passed the Legislature but has not yet been signed by the Governor. Comments on the revised draft forms are being requested by Friday, May 23, 2008. The revised draft forms are:

- Form DR-420 -- Certification of Taxable Value
- Form DR-420 VMA -- Voted Millage Addendum
- Form DR-420 TIF -- Tax Increment Adjustment Worksheet
- Form DR-420 MM-P -- Maximum Millage Levy Calculation Preliminary Disclosure
- Form DR-489 -- 2008 Preliminary Recapitulation of the Ad Valorem Assessment Roll (applicable only to property appraisers)

- Form DR-487 -- Certification of TRIM Compliance
- Form DR-487V -- Vote Record for Final Adoption of 2008-2009 Millage Levy
