SUBJ: HB 909 Data Publication Requirement
DATE: January 30, 2009

As required by s. 195.052, F.S., as amended by section 9 of Chapter 2008-197, L.O.F., (HB 909), the Department of Revenue has posted information on local government property tax levies on its website. Data is available for all non-voted property tax levies of city and county governments in the state. The data includes the previous and current year's millage rate, the current year's percentage increase in taxes levied above the "no budget increase" (rolled-back) rate and the annual percentage increase in total nonvoted property taxes levied. In a second table, information on the distribution of property taxes levied among the various classifications of property is included.
