SUBJ: County and Municipal Property Tax Data Pursuant to
Section 195.052, F.S.
DATE: January 29, 2010

As required by s. 195.052, F.S., the Department of Revenue has posted information on local government property tax levies on its website. Data is available for all non-voted property tax levies of city and county governments in the state. The data includes the previous and current years' millage rates, the current year's percentage increase in taxes levied above the "no budget increase" (rolled-back) rate and the annual percentage change in total non-voted property taxes levied. In a second table, information on the distribution of property taxes levied among the various classifications of property is included.
